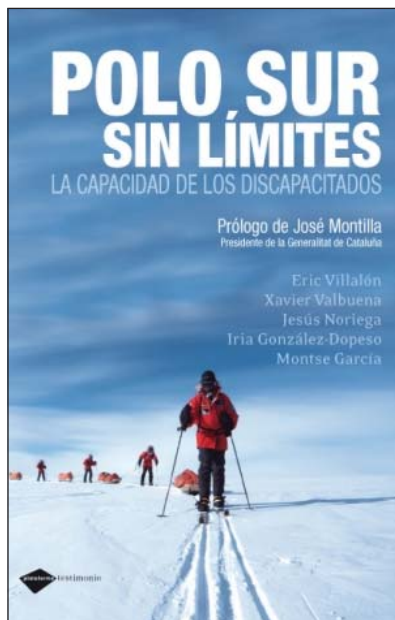

THE TASK

To get to the geographical South Pole by walking, from parallel 88 from where the legendary Shackleton expedition had to give up precisely 100 years ago.

THREE CHALLENGES

- To collect samples of ice from the central zone of the White Continent to analyse the impact of the industrial world on the last frontier of the Planet for the first time.
- To overcome the harshness of the weather and the personal difficulties of getting there before the forced evacuation from the Antarctic at the beginning of the relentless southern winter.
- To demonstrate that the inability to reach an objective is, often, a more mental than physical limitation.
