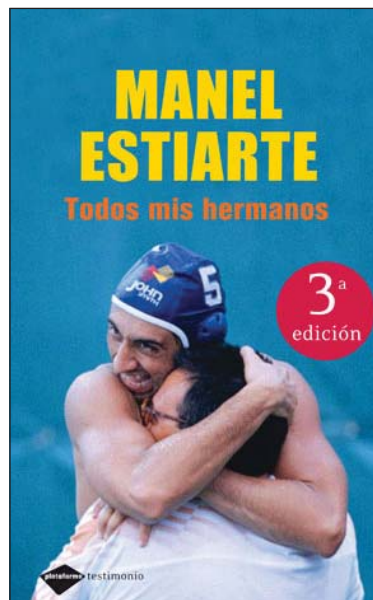

He was elected as the best player in the world for six years running, which gained him the Principe de Asturias Prize in Sport in 2001.
